If I make a change to one of the system dsn I set up 6 month ago, IIS will no longer recognize it.. For 32-bit applications under 64-bit Windows there's ODBC Data Source Administrator for the 32-bit ODBC drivers%systemdrive% Windows SysWoW64 odbcad32.. • Windows XP: Click the Remove or Change/Remove tab (to the right of the program).. I successfully set up two system dsn's using 32 bit VFP ODBC driver under Windows Web Server 2008 x64 6 months ago.. • On the Start menu (for Windows 8, right-click the screen's bottom-left corner), click Control Panel, and then, under Programs, do one of the following: • Windows Vista/7/8: Click Uninstall a Program..
